Application Procedures

CRITERIA:

1. The recipient will be presently employed in a teaching position. The recipient will have served as a licensed educator in the state of Kansas for a maximum of three years.
2. The recipient must show evidence of innovative instruction in his/her respective educational-related content area.

SELECTION PROCEDURES:

1. A selection committee will be appointed by the President of KASCD.
2. Nominations will be obtained from KASCD membership by the selection committee.
3. The nominee will submit the following information to: Dr. Corbin T. Witt, KASCD Recognition Chair, c/o Salina Public Schools, 1511 Gypsum; PO Box 797, Salina, KS 67401. Nominations may also be emailed to: Corbin.Witt@usd305.com
 - Autobiographical sketch
 - Statement of activities concerning outstanding work in curriculum, supervision and/or instructional leadership (list most current activities first)
 - Three letters of recommendation
4. Only one person may be recognized in one year. The award shall be an annual event. In the absence of a qualified application by the deadline, the Executive Board reserves the right to make nominations and selections from the field.
5. Recognition in the form of a plaque will be presented to the recipient.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

1. The selection chairperson shall be the KASCD Awards Chair and members of the KASCD Board of Directors.

CALENDAR:

1. March 1, 2012 is the deadline for submitting materials.
2. Awardees will receive their recognition in Topeka at the April 2012 Curriculum Leader's Meeting.
